Elim Church Council Meeting Highlights March 19, 2024

The council approved the recommendation from the property committee to select Pinnacle Roofing for replacing the flat roof, but the project is on hold while we wait for the response from the National Fund for Sacred Places. We submitted a Letter of Intent (thanks Barb Sackmann!) which is the first step in applying for a roof repair grant potentially worth \$100,000. One of their requirements is to not start the project before the grant is approved.

We plan to hold two information sessions in April about the current state of preparations for the capital campaign, roof replacement, and organ refurbishment.

We approved the finance committee's recommendation to hire Congregation Consulting Services to do a non-CPA evaluation of our financial procedures for the purpose of providing an independent opinion on the reasonableness of the congregation's financial statements and recommending improvements to its internal controls. This is much less expensive than a full CPA audit. We have a high regard for our current financial team and fully trust their capabilities, but the synod recommends a periodic evaluation by an outside entity.
