Altar Flowers

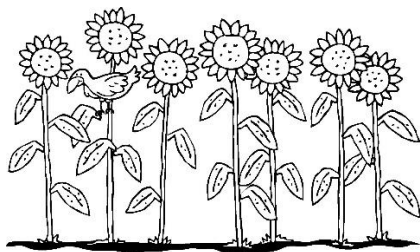
Attention All Elim Gardeners

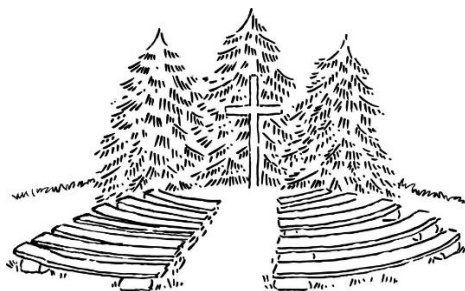
